Itinerary

Day 1 – OCT 6 (Tue) – Bucharest, Romania - Arrival in Berlin, Germany

An INTRA-TOUR flight is included from Bucharest to Berlin, Germany. Meet your Cosmos representative at the airport for your group transfer to the hotel. Enjoy the afternoon at leisure. This evening, join your Tour Director for a WELCOME DINNER. (D)

Day 2 – OCT 7 (Wed) - – Berlin–Wittenberg

Sightseeing with a Local Guide in the once-divided metropolis includes the elegant Ku'damm, the restored Reichstag, Charlottenburg Castle, a picture stop at monumental Brandenburg Gate, the Holocaust Memorial, and the 21-foot Victory Column in the vast Tiergarten Park. Visit the KAISER WILHELM MEMORIAL CHURCH with its bomb-damaged tower, drive along Unter den Linden Boulevard, and pass the State Opera House and Checkpoint Charlie. In the afternoon, continue to Wittenberg, Martin Luther's home for 30-plus years and birthplace of the Reformation. (B,D)

Day 3 – OCT 8 (Thur) - Wittenberg

Enjoy a guided walking tour of LUTHER HOUSE and MUSEUM, where Martin Luther and his family lived. This well-preserved place of Reformation relics includes Luther's desk, his pulpit, and first editions of his books. See St. Mary's Church, a twin-towered gothic church where Luther preached the Reformation, got married (1525), and baptized his six children. Finally, see the door of the Castle Church where Luther posted his 95 Theses against the sale of indulgences—and launched the Reformation in 1517. A special visit has been included to the renaissance-style MELANCHTHON HOUSE, built in 1536 and today a UNESCO World Heritage Site. It belonged to Philipp Melancthon, Luther's closest friend and most successful co-worker. (B,D)

Day 4 – OCT 9 (Fri) - Wittenberg–Dresden

This morning, travel to Dresden, the old capital of Saxony, at one time rightly called the "Florence on the Elbe." See the ZWINGER CARILLON PAVILION and much more of this city on your included sightseeing. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy at leisure. (B)

Day 5 – OCT 10 (Sat) - Dresden – Leipzig

On to Leipzig, where the great composers Johann Sebastian Bach and Felix Mendelssohn lived the last years of their lives. It was Mendelssohn who founded the Leipziger Conservatory in 1843. Visit the THOMASKIRCHE, where J.S. Bach worked. It is the home of the St. Thomas Boys Choir and a place of musical creativity. Also visit the market square that today is a site for celebrations and festivals but that once was the scene of executions and political demonstrations. (B,D)

Day 6 – OCT 11 (Sun) - Leipzig–Eisleben–Erfurt

Today, stop in Luther’s birthplace, Eisleben, and visit LUTHER’S BIRTHPLACE museum, LUTHER’S DEATH HOUSE MUSEUM, St. Andrew’s Church, and St. Peter & Paul Church. Later, drive to Erfurt, where the fine gothic and renaissance buildings evoke memories of the days of Dominican Master Eckhart and Martin Luther, who spent his student days here before embarking on his journey to Wittenberg. Highlight of the day is a visit to the AUGUSTINIAN MONASTERY, where Luther lived as a monk, and the MERCHANTS’ BRIDGE. (B)

Day 7 – OCT 12 (Mon) - Erfurt. excursion to Eisenach

This morning, enjoy a guided visit to WARTBURG CASTLE, where Luther translated the Bible. Also see the Luther and Bach Memorials, visit NIKOLAI CHURCH, and see the Nikolai Gate, through which Luther passed whenever he entered or left Eisenach. Return to Erfurt. (B,D)

Day 8 – OCT 13 (Tue) - Erfurt–Coburg–Mainz

In Coburg, where Luther stayed in 1530 for the Imperial Diet of Augsburg, visit fascinating COBURG FORTRESS, one of the largest surviving medieval fortresses in Germany. (B,D)

Day 9 – OCT 14 (Wed) – Mainz - Excursion to Worms & the Rhine Valley

In Worms, where the Imperial Council passed judgment on Luther in 1521, visit the CATHEDRAL where Luther presented his case, as well as TRINITY CHURCH and the famed REFORMATION MONUMENT. Later, enjoy a scenic RHINE CRUISE past castle-crested cliffs, terraced vineyards, and trim, half-timbered towns. This evening, your Tour Director hosts a special farewell dinner. Wonderful conversation and cuisine make the perfect finale for your vacation. (B,D)

Day 10 – OCT 15 (Thur) – Mainz - Frankfurt-Depart for home

Your tour ends with breakfast this morning. A group transfer will be provided to the airport for your homebound flights. (B)
